Prof Colleen Lau is a medical doctor and a researcher in infectious diseases. Her areas of expertise include travel medicine, emerging infectious diseases, neglected tropical diseases, global disease elimination programs, and spatial epidemiology. An area of special interest is the impact of global environmental change (including climate change, flooding, population growth, urbanization, globalization and biodiversity loss) on the emergence and transmission of infectious diseases.

In this presentation, Prof Lau will provide a brief overview of the COVID-19 experience in Australia and discuss the development of a real-time information dashboard and interactive mapping tool for COVID-19. The tool aims to optimize access and usability of surveillance data for clinicians, public health responders, and the general public.
