Hokkaido University is recruiting Ambitious Special Assistant Professors for the purpose of early development and support for various career paths of doctoral human resources.

We are looking for doctoral personnel who will take on the challenge of producing excellent research results and are interested in utilizing the research results in society. In particular, we are looking for young individuals who are willing to expand the scope of research beyond the boundaries of their fields, and have the potential to adapt to various career paths whether in academia or industry.

(3) Brief summary of previous research projects (approx. 500 words) (Form #3)

(4) Brief summary of your perspective concerning research (approx. 500 words) (Form #4)

Explain why your term of research activity will be an important part of your future career planning. You can also describe a research technology acquisition plan for use in the company you will work for in the future, or a study plan for utilizing the research results in society in order to start a business in the future. Please specify the magnitude of the academic/social contribution of the research results, changes from your previous research, and any plans to utilize the research in society.

(5) Activities for next-generation researchers (Form #5)

If you have experienced expanding your possibilities or having a clearer vision by participating in activities other than your speciality (cross-disciplinary researcher exchange activities, transferable skill improvement seminars, social contribution activities outside of academia, etc.) during your doctoral course or after obtaining your doctoral degree, please list them all (do not list activities that are typically attended by researchers in your specialized field). If you are supported by the Doctoral Fellowship at our university, all of that activity can be included. Please emphasize what was
